



SCP Illness Policy Reminders:

Cold and Flu Season is upon us and SCP follows specific guidelines when it comes to your child's health.

Our Teachers will conduct a daily health check. If your child appears ill we will ask that the child remain home until symptoms are gone.

Please do not send your child to school if he/she has had, within the last twenty-four hours:

- a fever of 100 ° or more
- Vomiting: 2 or more occasions
- Diarrhea: 3 or more watery stools within the past 24 hours or any bloody stool
- Rash (especially with fever or itching)
- Eye discharge or conjunctivitis (pink eye): until clear or 24 hours of antibiotic treatment
- Sick appearance, not feeling well, and/or not able to keep up with program activities
- Open or oozing sores, unless properly covered and 24 hours has passed since starting antibiotic treatment, if antibiotic treatment is necessary.
- Lice or scabies: until after treatment and symptoms are no longer present.

If your child has any communicable disease or has been too tired or sick to participate in daily activities, keep them home until they have recovered.

Please help us keep all the children in our program safe by notifying the school immediately if your child contracts a contagious disease. They may return to school when a physician indicates they are no longer contagious. P.26 of our Parent Handbook has a list of Reportable Washington State Communicable Diseases. Sunset Christian Preschool will report occurrences of communicable disease to the local health department, and notify all parents so that they can take appropriate action to protect their children.
